

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE

1. ACCEPTANCE AND CHANGES TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE

These Terms and Conditions of Use regulate the access and use of the Platform www.all4alzheimers.com (hereinafter referred to as "Platform"), made available by Adlife - Imagem e Comunicação, Lda. and under the responsibility of ROCHE Farmacêutica Química, Lda., with registered office at Estrada Nacional 249-1 Venteira, 2700 - 237 Amadora and with Tax ID number 500 233 810, (hereinafter referred to as "ROCHE").
